

How to register for and complete the training: Psychological First Aid for COVID-19 Frontline Workers in American Indian/Alaska Native Communities

Step 1: Create a CoursePlus account

What is CoursePlus?

[CoursePlus](#) is a learning management system at the Johns Hopkins University. You will need a free CoursePlus account to access training modules for the Psychological First Aid for COVID-19 Frontline Workers in American Indian/Alaska Native Communities course.


Creating a CoursePlus Account

1) To get started, click the [Sign in Here](#) link.



2) Then click [Create a CoursePlus account](#) from the login page.

3) Click the blue square that says [+Create](#). You will be directed to complete an online form (see image below). All fields marked with a red asterisk are required. Note: the form will ask whether you have signed up for or taken 'Introduction to Online Learning'. You can leave this box unchecked; you do not need to take this course.

Step 3: Complete the training

Navigating the Course Site

Once you create an account and login, you will be directed to the CoursePlus home page. Click on “Psychological First Aid for COVID-19 Frontline Workers in American Indian/Alaska Native Communities” under “My Trainings” to access the course content. Then utilize the tabs at the top right side of the course to navigate through the site.



There are five major sections within the course site:

- **Syllabus** has an overview of the course, including contact information for faculty and training support staff.
- **Content** provides access to all learning modules and training activities, [this tab is where you will find everything you need to complete the training.](#)
- **Communication** holds all the tools you will use to communicate with everyone in the course, including a discussion forum where you can post and respond to messages from other participants. [You do not need to use this function](#) to complete the training but you are welcome to use it to communicate with training staff and other participants.
- **Resources** contains an [online library](#) with psychological first aid training materials, resources for managing stress, and other training related materials.
- **Help** directs you to the CTL Help Center, where you can request support should you encounter any technical difficulties.
